## Seminar class № 3\_

**Topic:** Main deficit conditions in pediatrics. Rickets.

**Purpose:** To deepen knowledge and master the skills of assessing the physical development of newborn children, obtained in the course of studying the subject; promoting the development of creative thinking. The ability to logically express and argue one's thoughts, to listen to each other, to criticize productively.

**Basic concepts:** deficit conditions in pediatrics. Rickets.

Equipment: child's mannequin.

**Study time:** 2 hours.

## Plan

- I. Organizational moment (greetings, checking the audience, the message of the topic, the purpose of the lesson, the motivation of applicants to study the topic).
- II. Control of basic knowledge (frontal survey on basic terminology)

Questions to check basic knowledge on the topic of the seminar:

- 1. Main deficit conditions in pediatrics
- 2. Classification, diagnosis and treatment of rickets in children.
- 3. Mastering the communication skills of communicating with the parents of a child with manifestations of rickets.

Discussion of theoretical issues can take place in the form of role-playing, answers to questions, debates, discussions, presentations with reports, abstracts, discussion of reports and abstracts, review of applicant answers, etc.)

Themes of role play/reports/abstracts

- 1. Deficient conditions in pediatrics (report, discussion, discussion of reports and review of applicant answers).
- 2. Classification, diagnosis and treatment of rickets in children. (report, discussion, discussion of reports and review of applicant answers).
- 3. Survey, examination and medical management of a young child with rickets (as a result of insufficient intake of vitamin D, impaired absorption, or hereditary disorder of phosphorus-calcium metabolism) (role play)

When preparing a report, role-play, essay, analytical review, etc., applicants can, along with this, prepare didactic visual aids in the form of tables, code diagrams, slides, drawings, portraits of famous specialists, preparations, etc.).
